SWACHHATA PAKHWADA & SWACHHATA HI SEWA (SHS) 2025 (SWACHHOTSAV)

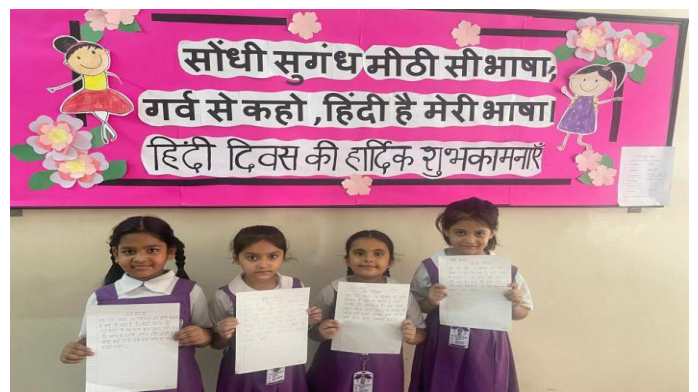
16th September- 2nd October, 2025
