

World Heritage Day, celebrated annually on April 18th, is a day dedicated to raising awareness about the diversity of our cultural heritage and the efforts required to


declamation, special assembly, and a movie screening were organised aiming at fostering appreciation for our rich cultural heritage.

The event left a lasting impact, inspiring all attendees to strive for greatness and embody the spirit of achievement in all aspects of life.






## Labour Day Celebration 1<sup>st</sup> May'2024
