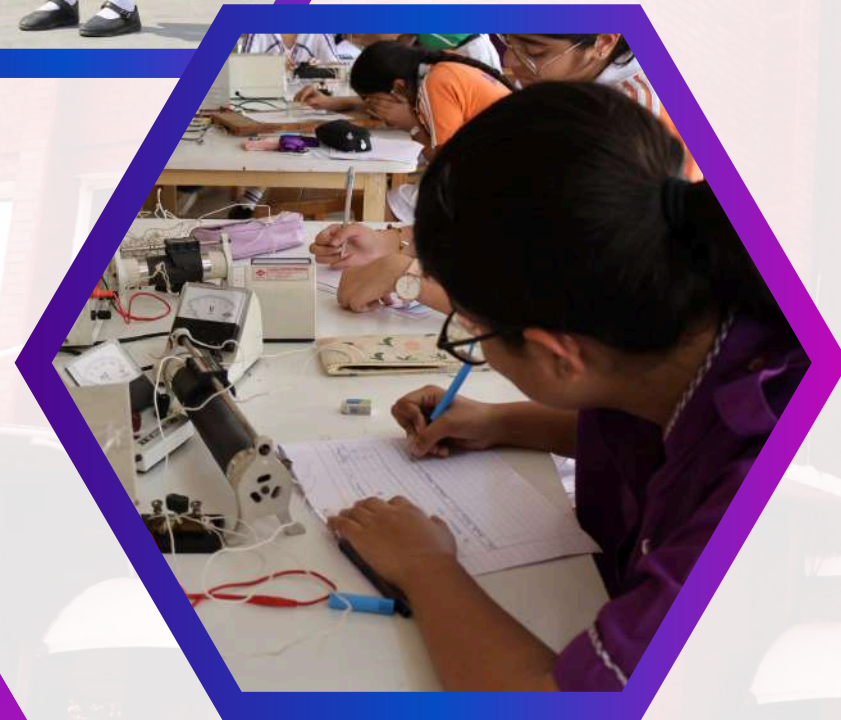

INSPIRE awards are one of the most prestigious fellowship offered to schools students by Govt. of India , Ministry of Science & Technology. The INSPIRE – MANAK (Million Minds Augmenting National Aspiration and Knowledge) is one of the flagship scheme of Department of Science and Technology (DST), Govt. of India for nurturing ideas and innovations of school students and motivate them to pursue science and a career in research, jointly implemented by Department of Science and Technology (DST) and the National Innovation Foundation (NIF) – India. It is an initiative to foster a culture of innovation and creative thinking amongst school students to address the societal need through Science and Technology by targeting one million original ideas/innovations rooted in science and societal applications.

Ministry has selected and sanctioned only 248 project proposals this academic sessions. Our school had submitted two project proposals for the very prestigious awards in the field of science . I am extremely elated to share that both proposals submitted by our schools have been recognised and accepted by Department of Science & Technology, Govt. of India and have been offered fellowships for the same.
