Through this experiential journey, you will awaken your **Kaushal Bodh** (skill-awareness), transforming textbook knowledge into real-world competencies and practical life skills.

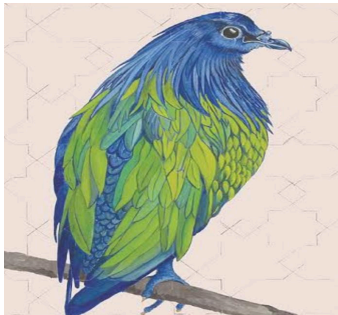

Your Guides: Tara the Nicobar Pigeon and Duggy the Dugong's story



*“Our islands are filled with wonderful plants, animals, forests, and oceans,” says Tara. “But today, our homes are facing danger. Trees are being cut down, and the seas are becoming polluted. We need your help to protect our precious biodiversity -our living treasure!”*

*Duggy adds “When people care for nature, forests stay green, oceans stay clean, and animals like us can live safely. Together, we can protect our islands for future generations.”*

### **Tara and Duggy invite you to become true Guardians of the Islands!**

Your Mission: Create, Discover, and Protect with Tara and Duggy!

- Build a Mini Diorama with Tara and Duggy

**Create a beautiful 3-D diorama** showing the habitats of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Include: Forest areas with tall trees and Tara’s nesting spots. Ocean scenes with coral reefs where Duggy swims.

(Use natural/recycled materials like leaves, sand, clay, pebbles, shells, and twigs to make your diorama colourful and realistic)

- **Create an attractive ocean-themed bookmark** showing Duggy the Dugong swimming peacefully through the colourful coral reefs of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.
- Imagine a day in the life of Tara or Duggy. **Write a short story or create a comic strip showing:**

Their adventures in the forests or oceans.

The challenges they face due to pollution or habitat loss.

How they help keep the island ecosystem healthy.

Why protecting biodiversity is important for all living beings.

(Use creativity, colours, and imagination to bring their story to life)

Tara the Nicobar Pigeon needs your help to protect animals travelling between Mount Harriet National Park and Madhuban Forest.

**Design a Wildlife Rescue Corridor-** On an A3 sheet, draw both forests and connect them with a wildlife corridor. The real distance is 1.8 km (1800 m). Using the scale 1 cm = 300 m, the map distance will be 6 cm. If the corridor width is 60 m, calculate its area.

Decorate your map with trees, rivers, hills, animal footprints, and write how wildlife corridors help Andaman Wild Pig and other animals move safely and protect biodiversity.
